



Unreliable access



- Detailed Research often the Basis of Future Journal Articles
- Dissertations play the role of preparatory stage before publications in journals
- Literature Review Dissertations are required to contain a comprehensive bibliographic information














Genealogy Tree for Advisor Stark, Stephen L.


Genealogy Tree for Advisor Hurtado, Sylvia
