Concordia's GradProSkills program is housed in the School of Graduate Studies. Its purpose is to complement graduate academic programs by providing resources that are tailored to graduate student's needs and which help ensure our student's academic success and integration into the labour market.

Structure

- Every year we offer more than 325 workshops covering eight different skill domains (see below).
- These workshops are free for current students, post-doctoral fellows and recent alumni in our Master's, PhD, Graduate Diploma/Certificate programs.
- We also organize special events such as the 3 Minute Thesis Competition, Thesis Boost: 3-day writing retreat, and networking with Concordia alumni.
- To develop content and deliver workshops we collaborate with more than 25 internal Concordia partners and external partners from the Montreal community.
- Every spring, we hire a team of approximately 15 graduate students to help with workshop development, delivery, logistics, marketing and social media.
- We publish online resources including our <u>GradProBlog</u> and <u>short videos</u>, and are active on <u>Facebook</u>, <u>LinkedIn</u> and <u>Twitter</u>.






