- Fall 2017 Graduate Summit devoted to generating support for Accelerated Program Options
 - Financially attractive model, especially for EIU
 Students; 9 "shared" credit hours = ~\$3,000 in savings
 - New graduate enrollment funnel
 - New undergraduate enrollment funnel
 - Attractive to undergraduate transfer students
 - Commonly accepted practice
 - 2017-2018 Goal: create the rules/procedures for accelerated programs > then program adoptions
