

Half century of social science research to assess the extent to which internationalization of American social science has occurred

The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill

Google Scholar's coverage of the engineering literature 10 years later, published in *PennState ScholarSphere*, March 2018.

The authors used data from full-text engineering dissertations published in 2016 to and related citations to determine the change in engineering literature referenced in Google Scholar over the last 10 years.

Computing research in the academy: insights from theses and dissertations, published in *Scientometrics*, January 2018.

The authors analyzed computing-related keywords in approximately 30,000 dissertations and theses

Neuroscience bridging scientific disciplines in health: Who builds the bridge, who pays for it?, published in *Scientometrics*, November 2018.

By examining the topics of more than 500,000 doctoral dissertations from U.S. institutions in six major disciplines in 1996-2014, the study investigated the dynamics of cross-disciplinary research in health-related fields as affected by individual and institutional factors.

Published through Stanford University. The authors use analysis of ProQuest Dissertations and Theses Global abstracts from authors at research-intensive institutions to assess if those institutions are "forward-leaning" or "past-leaning" in their relationship to academia.



- Hosted by ProQuest












