

bachelor's degree








- Requirements:
 - Honor students (GPA ≥ 3.25)
 - Approve a minimum number of undergraduate credit-hours
 - Permission from the Undergraduate Program Director and Graduate Program Coordinator
 - Approval of the Graduate School Dean
- Graduate courses count towards the bachelor's degree (not a dual program)
- Financial Aid covers the tuition of graduate courses




Demographics - Last three terms
