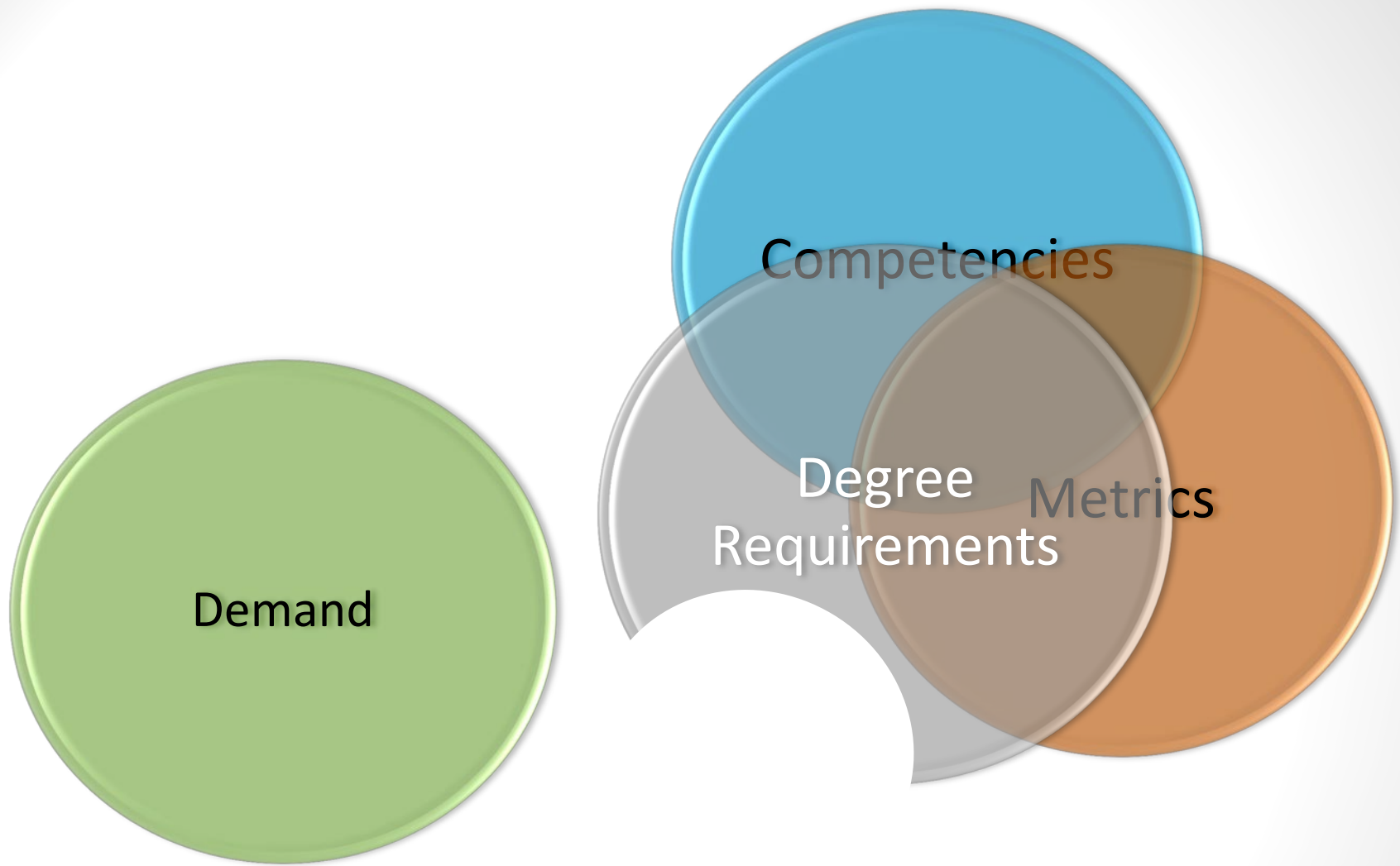
Requirements Lacking Alignment with Competencies

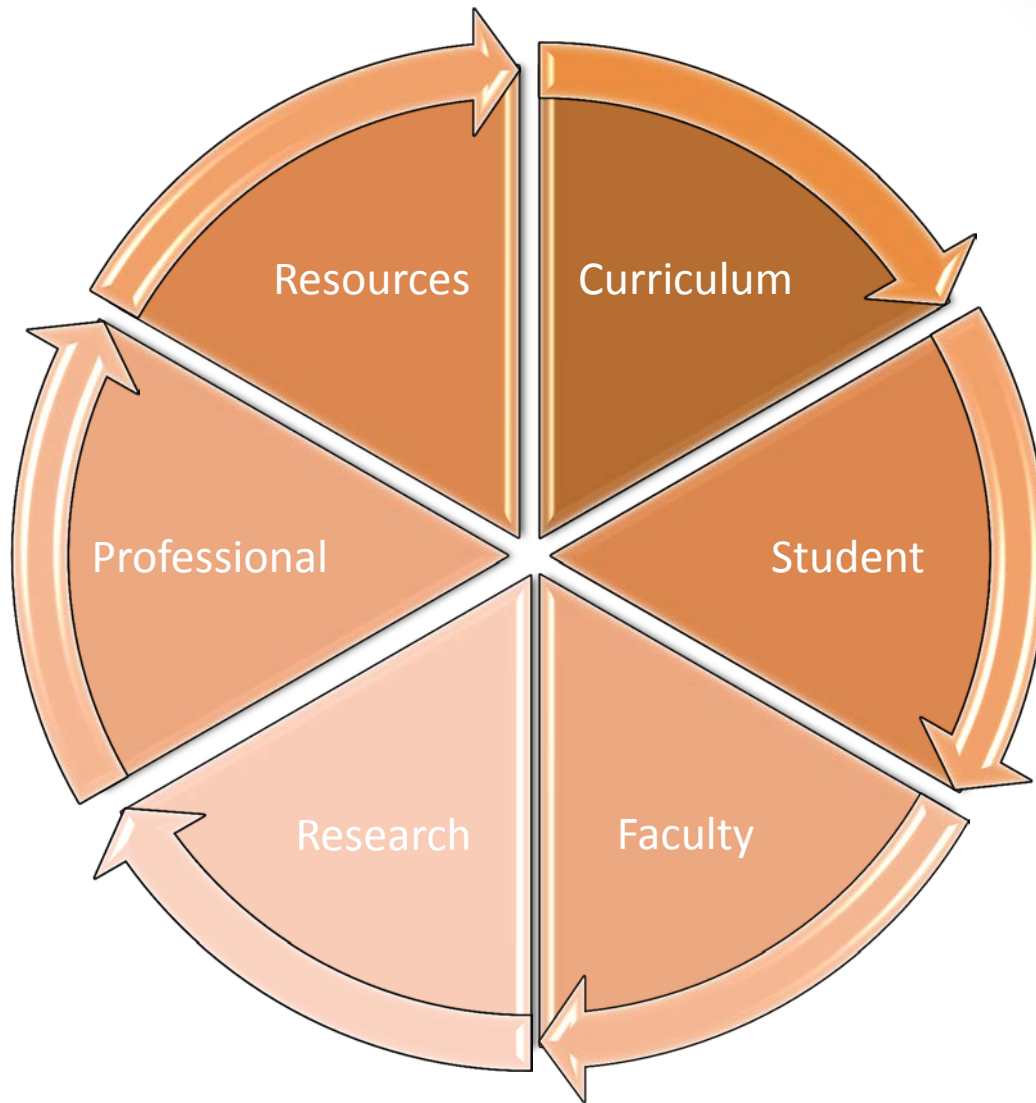

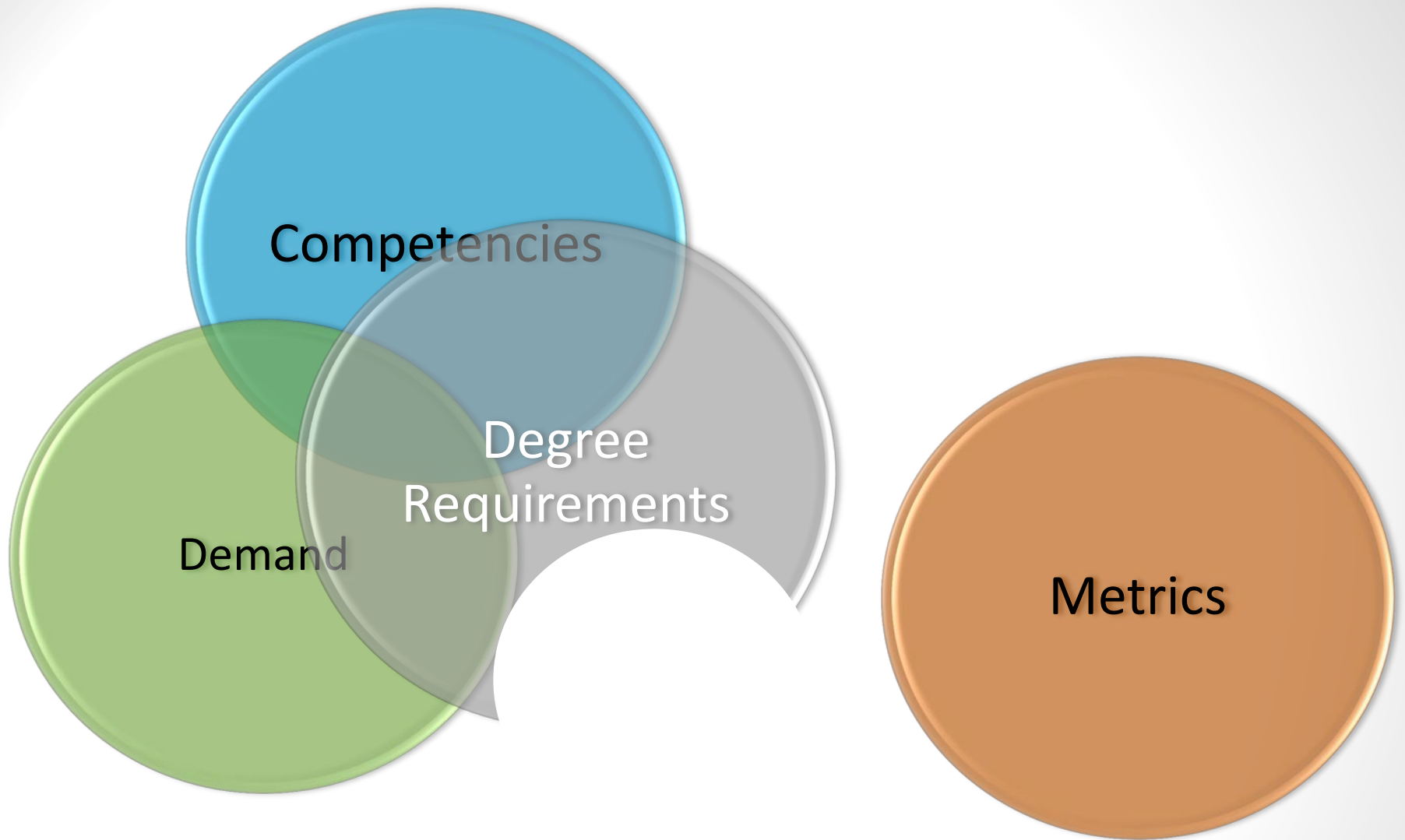

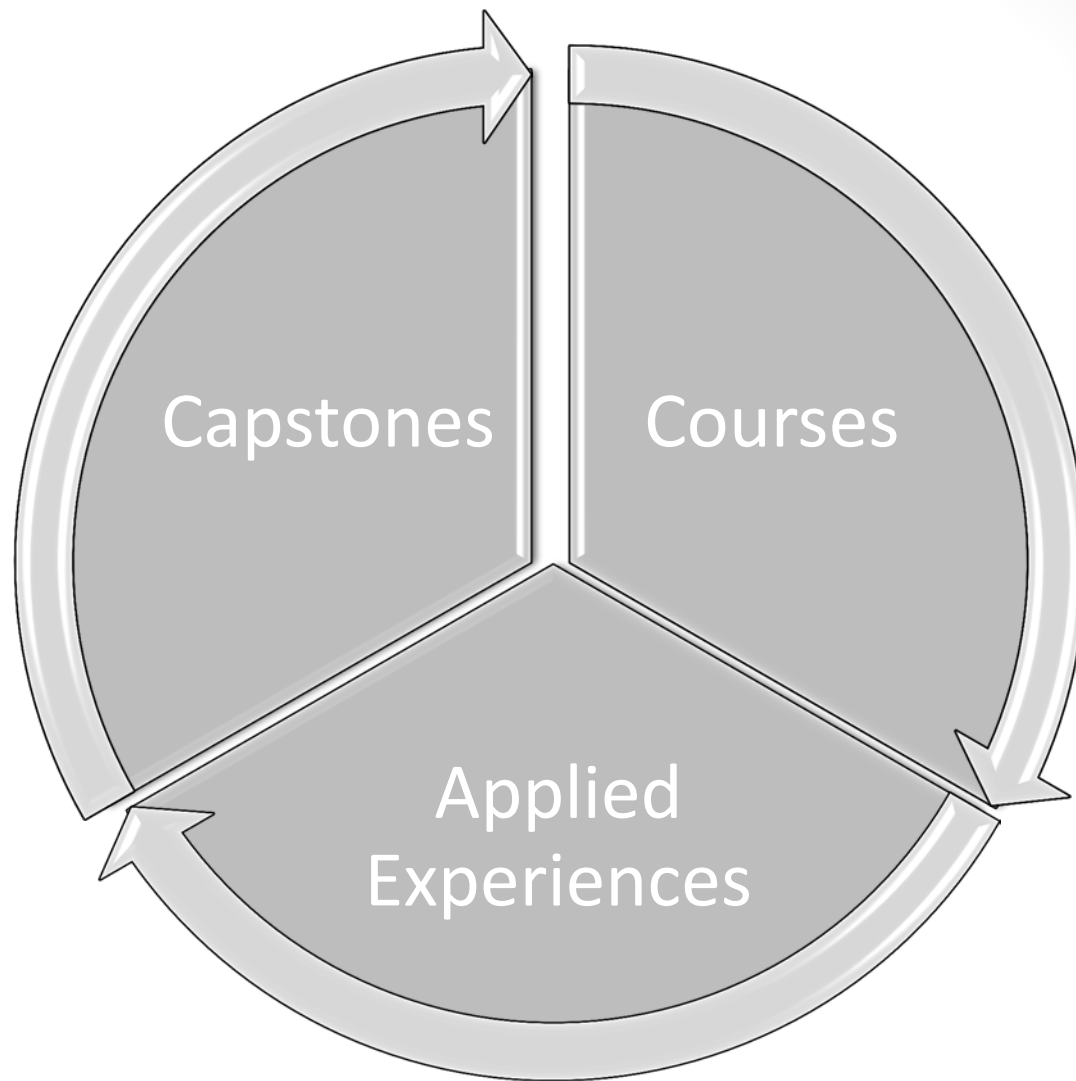

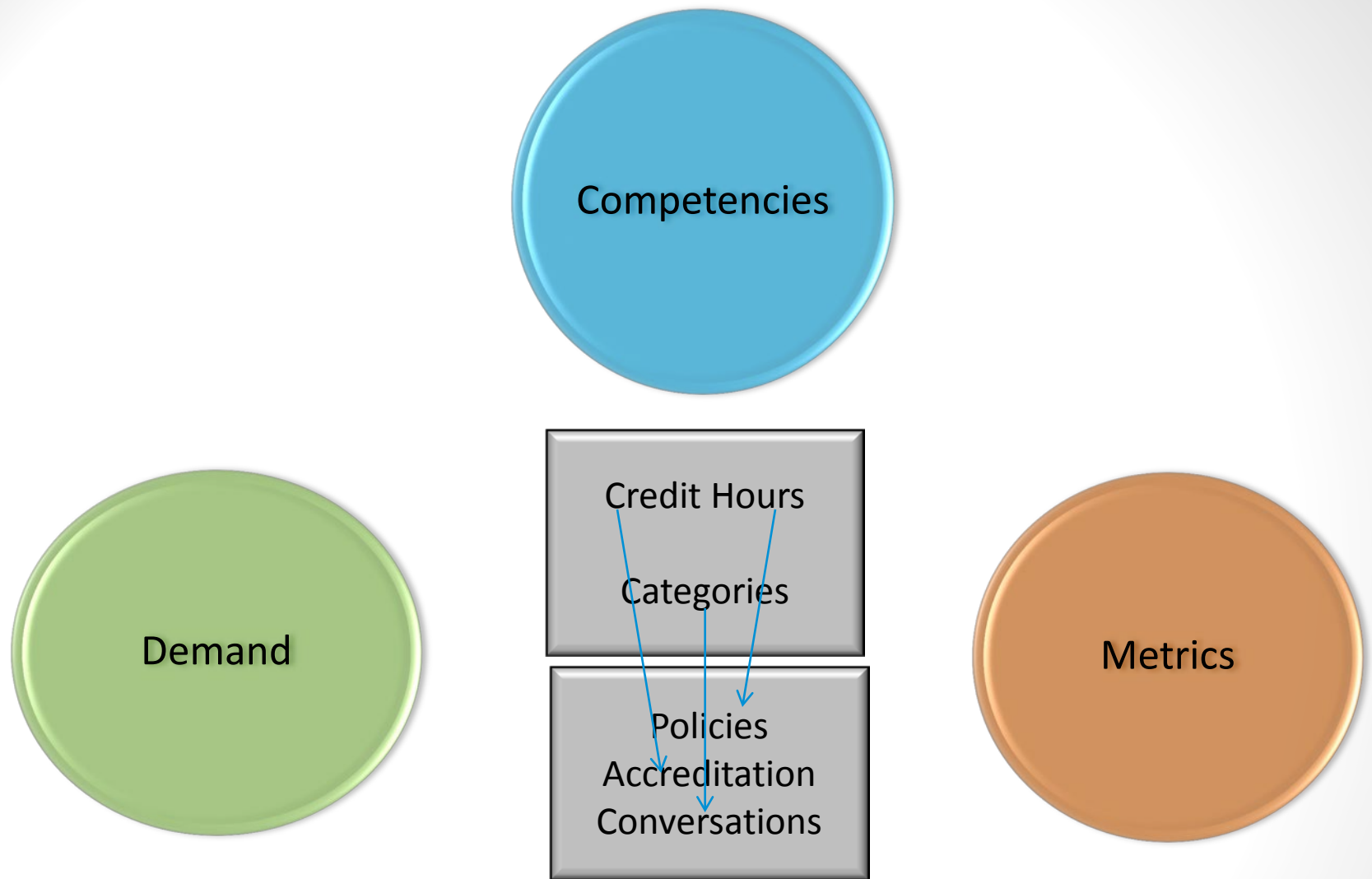

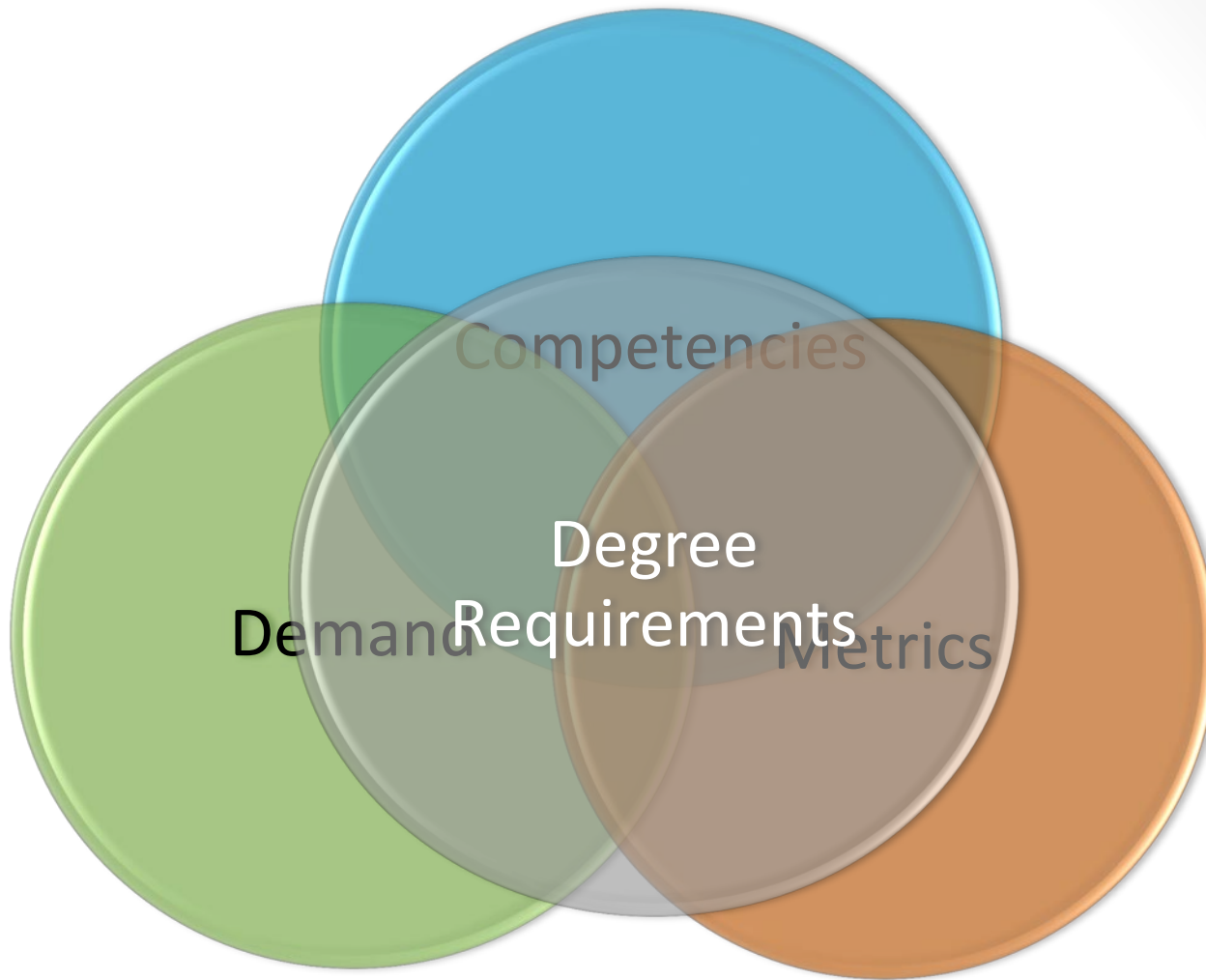
