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Entry-Level Hires into Federal Agencies


In FY 2008, roughly **101,805** people were hired in the federal government at the GS-5, GS-6, GS-7 and GS-9 levels into the following occupations:

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Where the Jobs Are: An Overview

★ Survey of 35 federal agencies

- Represents approximately 99% of federal workforce
- Executive branch agencies with 1,000+ fulltime, permanent employees
- ★ Mission-critical hiring projections



Where the Jobs Are: Top Line Findings

★ Nearly 273,000 projected mission-critical hires between fiscal 2010 to 2012

- 41% increase over the previous survey
- ★ All types of jobs, across the country and around the world
- **★** Hiring concentrated in 5 categories




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Where the Jobs Are: Top Five Fields





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Barriers to Federal Service: Lack of Knowledge


- ★ 42% interested in government

- ★ Don't equate government service with public service

Where the Jobs Are

A new report — Where the Jobs Are: Mission Critical Opportunities for America, released by the Partnership for Public Service, outlines government-wide projected hiring needs through 2009 and is based on a survey of 34 federal agencies representing nearly 99 percent of the federal workforce. The survey finds nearly 193,000 mission critical jobs need to be filled in the next two years!
