

Dr. Brian S. Mitchell is the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS) Dean-in-Residence to the Division of Graduate Education (DGE) at the National Science Foundation (NSF), and Professor of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering at Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana. He served as Associate Provost for Graduate Studies and Research at Tulane from 2006 to 2014. Brian graduated with a B.S. from the University of Illinois-Urbana, and with M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, all in Chemical Engineering. Brian is a Fellow of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers. He is a member of the DAAD Alumni Association Board and is a DAAD Research Ambassador.
