




## Graduate Deans Predictions: GRE Volumes in 2009

At the CGS summer workshop, we posed this question:


Given what you know at this time, what is your prediction for GRE Volumes for the remainder of 2009?








### Respondent "Votes"







### Total GRE Volumes (2005-2009)




2009 Year-todate volumes are +8% compared to 2008





### GRE Domestic Volumes (2005-2009)




2009

### ETS® Personal Potential Index (ETS® PPI)




- ETS PPI is a web-based evaluation system that provides evaluator ratings on specific personal attributes that graduate deans and faculty have identified as essential for success in graduate or professional school
- ETS PPI provides a more complete picture of your graduate applicants
- The launch of ETS PPI marks the first large-scale use of noncognitive measures for admissions in higher education





### The ETS® PPI System


- Applicants select evaluators who know them well, e.g. Faculty, employers
  - Up to 5 evaluators per report
- Evaluators rate applicant on
  - 6 personal attributes
  - Overall rating
- Evaluators may also provide qualitative comments







### ETS® PPI Evaluation Reports



- Reports are sent directly to institutions, with graphic charts that present both quantitative information and qualitative comments
- Reports are sent via paper, but institutions may also receive PDFs of ETS PPI results electronically via the SCORELINK® Internet delivery service





### ETS® PPI – Based on a Decade of Research

- Research by ETS scientists and others in the field
- Feedback from hundreds of graduate and professional school deans and faculty members
- Pilot-tested for over three years through Project 1000 at Arizona State University
- ETS is committed to ongoing validity studies exploring the relationship between these attributes and success in graduate and professional school

### My Credentials Vault Service



#### **Powered by Interfolio**

- My Credentials Vault service is a web-based tool to simplify the letter of recommendation process
- Candidates can sign up for 1, 3, or 5 year accounts
- Service is free for letter writers and graduate programs
